**\*Standing Committees**

**NOTE: On June 10, 2004, the general membership approved the following FSBA Bylaws amendment:**

**Each district school board shall designate annually at the organization meeting held pursuant to Section 1001.371, Florida Statutes, a member and an alternate to serve on the Legislative Committee as the FSBA legislative liaison, and shall inform the FSBA Office of such appointments by the established deadline.**

## FSBA COMMITTEES

★**Board Development Committee:** Plans, guides, and monitors the implementation of the Board Development Program which includes the Certified Board Member and Master Board Programs, the Advanced Boardmanship Certification, and the Certified Board distinction.

★**Bylaws and Procedures Committee:** Assists in the review, development, and revision of the FSBA Bylaws and Operating Procedures and facilitate the adoption process of any proposed changed.

★**Finance Committee:** Monitors the financial operation and budgetary process of FSBA.

**Florida Learning First Alliance:** To take the lead in assisting various groups in the state of Florida to form an educational alliance with the Learning First Alliance.

**Growth Management & Affordable Housing Committee:** Oversight Committee to monitor and report on all developments that relate to the growth management requirements for cities, counties, and local school boards. The Committee will oversee all “Affordable Housing” issues for school personnel.

★**Legislative Committee:** Coordinates a systematic process to develop equitable and responsive legislative platforms for FSBA and pursues legislative changes consistent with the adopted FSBA legislative platforms. Two (2) subcommittees shall be permanently established for the Legislative Committee:

**Federal Relations Network Subcommittee (FRN):** Explores and coordinates programs, legislation, and activities between FSBA and federal agencies and elected officials. The FSBA President shall appoint the chairman of this Subcommittee after consultation with the Chairman of the Legislative Committee.

**Advocacy Subcommittee:** Explores strategies and ways of strengthening FSBA’s advocacy role in public education and shall keep advocacy in the forefront of public education. This Subcommittee shall be chaired by the vice-chairman of the Legislative Committee.

★**Multicultural and Diversity Committee:** Sensitizes and cultivates positive images and attitudes among school board members on multicultural education issues and recommends program topics for workshops and conferences.

★**Past Presidents’ Committee:** Serves in an advisory capacity to the Executive Officers on issues of governance, seeks ways and strategies to advance the FSBA President’s focus area, recruit leaders for FSBA, and performs other duties as assigned by the FSBA President.

**Technology Committee:** Oversee the upgrading of technology in the FSBA Office, and implementing of the technology plan with the full membership to ensure that updated information is relayed in a timely fashion.

**Ad Hoc Committee - FSBA Function and Services:** This Ad Hoc Committee shall review the function and services of the Florida School Boards Association, survey FSBA members to determine which FSBA services are relevant to member needs, review the FSBA Procedures Manual to determine if current FSBA services are aligned with the function described in the Procedures Manual, and present recommendations to revise, add to, or eliminate current services.

**Ad Hoc Committee - Florida’s Economic Commitment to Public Education:** This Ad Hoc Committee shall evaluate potential state revenue sources, consider whether the revenue is consistent with education funding principles, and develop strategies to ensure that appropriate new revenues are earmarked to augment current education funding.
