The *Master Board (MB) Program* is designed for a school district's leadership team, that is, the school board members and the superintendent. Participation in the Master Board Program is available to school districts every two (2) years and is offered subsequent to school board elections in November of even-numbered years.

The Master Board Program features a skills-based curriculum to strengthen the leadership team's ability to work effectively, efficiently, and collectively as a governance group while maintaining a focus on student

learning and factors contributing to the success of schools. It requires twenty-two (22) hours of training of which ten (10) hours are prescribed curriculum at a Master Board Forum (see dates below); the remaining

twelve (12) hours, completed in three (3) onsite workshops, are elective. The training topics for the elective curriculum must be selected from specific leadership modules developed by FSBA.

Leadership Teams must attend one (1) forum chosen from the dates listed. Dates fill up quickly, on a first-come, first-served basis. Spots are reserved once "Letter of Intent to Participate" and participation fee is received by the FSBA office.
