Rule No.: 6A-6.0576

Purpose: To specify the procedures and timelines for implementation of an industry certification process and adoption of the CAPE Industry Certification Funding List changes. This rule amendment will: 1) Adopt an updated CAPE Industry Certification Funding list which will impact funding calculations associated with industry certification attainment; 2) Add language on the implementation of 0.3 full-time equivalent student membership for student completion of at least three courses and an industry certification in a single career and technical education program or program of study; 3) Adopt the 2023-2024 Secondary Career and Technical Education (CTE) Program to Certification Linkages list for implementation of the 0.3 full-time equivalent student membership for student completion of at least three courses and an industry certification in a single career and technical education program or program of study.

Purpose: To adopt a process for the review and approval of postsecondary career dual enrollment courses for the additional FTE membership in the Florida Education Finance Program (FEFP). SB 240 amended the FEFP funding statute to add a value of 0.08 full-time equivalent student membership for each student who completes a career course through the dual enrollment program with a grade of "A" in a pathway that leads to an industry certification that is included on the CAPE Industry Certification Funding List.

Purpose: To implement changes to the Open Door Grant Program associated with Chapter 2023-81, Laws of Florida, due to the passing of Senate Bill 240 during the 2023 legislative session that modifies section 1009.895, Florida Statutes, to convert the Open Door Grant Program to a financial aid program for students of a state college or technical center to incentivize current and future workers to enroll in CTE that leads to a credential, certificate, or degree. The statutory modifications require participating postsecondary institutions to administer the grant program in accordance with rules of the State Board of Education.

Purpose: To implement changes to the EASE grant program associated with Chapter 2023-93, Laws of Florida, due to the passing of Senate Bill 1272 during the 2023 legislative session, that includes the creation of a postsecondary educational grant under the EASE grant program and expands postsecondary institutional eligibility under the program. Effective July 1, 2023, statutory modifications expand postsecondary institutional eligibility for the EASE grant program allowing for additional students to access EASE grant program funds.

Purpose: To implement changes to the Dual Enrollment Scholarship Program stemming from Chapter 2023-16, Laws of Florida, due to the passing of House Bill 1 during the 2023 legislative session, that includes the creation of personalized education programs for secondary students. Effective July 1, 2023, statutory modifications authorize students in a personalized education program access to the same programs and services as home education program students, such as the ability to participate within dual enrollment programs at a public postsecondary institution. The Dual Enrollment Scholarship Program procedures are being modified to allow participating public postsecondary institutions the ability to be reimbursed tuition and instructional materials costs for dual enrollment courses taken by personalized education program students.

Changes in the publication and the chart of accounts include: (1) the addition of elements of financial statements for presentation in accordance with Governmental Accounting Standards Board principles; and (2) account modifications to clarify reporting purposes.

Purpose: The rule facilitates the statewide articulation of industry certifications pursuant to sections 1007.23 and 1008.44, F.S., which require the Articulation Coordinating Committee to recommend articulation agreements to the State Board of Education that provide for the articulation of postsecondary credit toward related degrees for earned industry certifications. The rule identifies these agreements as Gold Standard Career Pathways Articulation Agreements. The amendment will incorporate the Gold Standard Career Pathways Articulation Agreements for Industry Certifications to Associate of Science (AS) and Associate of Applied Science (AAS) Degrees document for 2023-24.
