Rule No.: 6A-6.0577

Purpose: The purpose of this new rule is to adopt a process for the review and approval of postsecondary career dual enrollment courses for the additional FTE membership in the Florida Education Finance Program (FEFP). SB 240 (2023) amended the FEFP funding statute to add a value of 0.08 full-time equivalent student membership for each student who completes a career course through the dual enrollment program with a grade of "A" in a pathway that leads to an industry certification that is included on the CAPE Industry Certification Funding List.

Rule No.: 6A-10.0342

Purpose: This amended rule establishes a process and procedure for the implementation of Section 1003.491(5), F.S., that requires the Commissioner of Education to conduct an annual review of K-12 and postsecondary career and technical education (CTE) offerings and to phase out programs that do not meet targets. The effect of the rule is to ensure that CTE programs are high performing and prepare students for in-demand occupations.

Purpose: To incorporate the school grading scale for the 2023-24 school grades results and to incorporate technical changes to update alternate assessment language to align with language in Rule 6A-1.0943, F.A.C., and remove reference to the English Language Proficiency Assessment, which is no longer used in the determination of learning gains for English Language Learners.
