**Notice of Development of Rulemaking**

Department: Department of Education

Division: State Board of Education

Rule No.: 6A-5.078

Purpose: The purpose of the rule development is to establish a new rule that will support implementation of Section 1012.56, F.S., as amended by Senate Bill 7002 (2024). The statutory amendment allows certified educators to place their certificates in an inactive status. Newly adopted amendments to Rule 6A-4.004(14)(e), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), provide that where a certificate has been inactive for more than a year, professional learning requirements must be met to reactivate. This rule will prescribe those professional learning requirements.

Purpose: The purpose of this rulemaking is to adopt the secondary and postsecondary career education programs prescribed in Sections 1004.92 and 1011.80, Florida Statutes, and listed as follows: "Agriculture, Food & Natural Resources," "Architecture & Construction," "Arts, A/V Technology & Communication," "Business, Management & Administration," "Education & Training," "Energy," "Finance," "Government & Public Administration," "Health Science," "Hospitality & Tourism," "Human Services," "Information Technology," "Law, Public Safety & Security," "Manufacturing," "Marketing, Sales & Service," "Engineering and Technology Education," "Transportation, Distribution & Logistics," and "Additional CTE Programs/Courses," all of which fall under the umbrella of the "Career and Technical Education Programs, Academic Year 2024-2025." In addition, the rule will adopt the "Adult General Education Standards and Curriculum Frameworks 2024-2025" required by statute. This amendment also removes language that was repealed by SB 7004 (2024) related to the program certification of Automotive Service Technology Education Programs.

Purpose: This amendment updates the rule that governs the administration of the Hope Scholarship Program. House Bill 1403 (2024) streamlined many of the provisions to the Hope Scholarship Program, including its original funding source (sales tax contributions from motor vehicle sales) and merged it with the Florida Tax Credit Scholarship, but its requirements for parental notification for the incidents in s. 1002.40(3), F.S., remain.
