Purpose: The purpose of this rule development is to address changes made by the 2024 Florida Legislature in House Bill (HB) 1291, Educator Preparation Programs, effective July 1, 2024. The amendments will provide parameters for content

in education preparation courses.

Purpose: The purpose of the rule amendment is to add enrollment criteria for individual programs. The amendment also removes Forms 11 and 12 from the Tests of Adult Basic Education to align with the naming of other assessments listed in the rule. Additionally, the amendment includes ACT WorkKeys Applied Math and ACT WorkKeys Workplace Documents as approved assessments and removes outdated language referencing assessments used for diagnosing students with disabilities. Furthermore, it eliminates references to Literacy Completion Points and replaces them with Measurable Skill Gains. Additional changes to the rule will also be considered.

Purpose: The purpose of the rule is to support implementation of Section 1012.56, Florida Statutes, as amended by Senate Bill 7002 (2024). The statutory amendment allows certified educators to place their certificates in an inactive status and requires the department to prescribe professional learning requirements that educators must complete to reactivate a certificate that has been inactive for more than one year.

requirements for parental notification for the incidents in s. 1002.40(3), F.S., remain.
