## **Audience & Focus**

- Your session will be attended by Florida School Board Members. Ensure your content is directly relevant to their role as policymakers.
- Avoid language that addresses staff, educators, superintendents, or administrators.
- Address challenges that school board members face and offer actionable insights.

## **Presentation Best Practices**

- Engagement is key Our members prefer interactive sessions over traditional lectures or PowerPoint-driven talks. Plan at least one interactive element (polling, group discussion, case study, or problem-solving exercise).
- Encourage real-world application by providing examples or scenarios relevant to school board decision-making.
- Visual learners Consider using handouts to reinforce key points.
- **Time Management** Your session is 60 minutes long. If co-presenting, coordinate with your fellow presenter to divide the time equally while ensuring you leave room at the end for questions and discussion.
- Session control Presenters should manage discussions to prevent any single attendee from monopolizing time. Moderators can assist if needed.
- Avoid overloading attendees with too much content—focus on key takeaways.
- Avoid political or controversial topics unless relevant to the discussion.
