HB 0005 **Civic Education Curriculum** by Zika

Civic Education Curriculum: Revises social studies high school graduation credit requirement; requires DOE to develop or approve integrated civic education curriculum that meets certain requirements; requires department to curate oral history resources to be used with such curriculum; requires department to approve civic education curricula submitted by school districts & charter schools. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0017 **Podiatric Medicine** by Bell

Podiatric Medicine: Authorizes Board of Podiatric Medicine to require specified number of continuing education hours related to safe & effective prescribing of controlled substances; provides for governance of podiatric physicians who are supervising medical assistants. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0037 **Abandoned Cemeteries** by Driskell

Abandoned Cemeteries: Creates Task Force on Abandoned African-American Cemeteries; specifies composition, purpose, & duties of task force; provides meeting requirements; requires task force to submit report to Governor & Legislature; provides for expiration of task force. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 0044 **Use of Drones by Government Agencies** by Wright

Use of Drones by Government Agencies; Expanding the authorized uses of drones by law enforcement agencies and other specified entities for specified purposes; requiring the Department of Management Services, in consultation with a specified officer, to publish a list of approved drone manufacturers meeting specified security standards; requiring governmental agencies to discontinue the use of specified drones by a certain date; requiring the department to establish minimum security standards for governmental agency drone use, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 0046 **Craft Distilleries** by Hutson

Craft Distilleries; Authorizing craft distilleries to be licensed as specified vendors under certain circumstances; requiring certain alcoholic beverages to be obtained through a licensed distributor; prohibiting a distillery from operating as a craft distillery until certain requirements are met; authorizing persons to have common ownership in craft distilleries under certain circumstances; requiring a minimum percentage of a craft distillery's total finished branded products to be distilled in this state and contain one or more Florida agricultural products after a specified date, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 0050 **Taxation** by Gruters

Taxation; Citing this act as the "Park Randall 'Randy' Miller Act"; revising the definition of the term "retail sale" to include sales facilitated through a marketplace; requiring marketplace providers and persons located outside of this state to remit discretionary sales surtax when delivering tangible personal property to a county imposing a surtax; providing that a marketplace seller, rather than the marketplace provider, is liable for sales tax collection and remittance under certain circumstances; requiring certain amounts to be deposited into the Unemployment Compensation Trust Fund during specified periods, etc. APPROPRIATION: \$353,000 Effective Date: Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act and except for this section, which shall take effect upon this act becoming a law, this act shall take effect July 1, 2021

SB 0052 **Postsecondary Education** by Rodrigues (R)

Postsecondary Education; Revising grant specifications; requiring funds appropriated for the Florida Postsecondary Comprehensive Transition Program to only be used for certain grants as specifically authorized in the General Appropriations Act; renaming collegiate high school programs as early college

programs; clarifying fee exemptions for the Department of Children and Families; establishing the Dual Enrollment Scholarship Program; providing for the reimbursement of tuition and costs to eligible postsecondary institutions; requiring students participating in dual enrollment programs to meet specified minimum eligibility requirements in order for institutions to receive reimbursements, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

HB 0053 Public Works by DiCeglie

Public Works: Revises prohibition relating to solicitation for construction services paid for with state appropriated funds; prohibits state or political subdivision that contracts for public works project from taking specified action against certain persons that are engaged in public works project or have submitted bid for such project; requires OEDR to include an analysis of certain expenditures in its annual assessment; requires counties, municipalities, & special districts that provide wastewater services & stormwater management to develop needs analysis. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 0056 Community Association Assessment Notices by Rodriguez (A)

Community Association Assessment Notices; Requiring condominium associations to maintain specified affirmative acknowledgments as official records of the association; revising timeframes for foreclosure judgments; requiring condominium associations to deliver certain invoices for assessments or statements of account to unit owners in a specified manner; requiring cooperative associations to maintain specified affirmative acknowledgments as official records of the association, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

HB 0059 Growth Management by McClain

Growth Management: Requires comprehensive plans & certain land development regulations of municipalities effective after certain date to incorporate certain development orders; requires local governments to include property rights element in their comprehensive plans; provides statement of rights; requires local government to adopt property rights element within specified timeframe; provides that certain property owners are not required to consent to development agreement changes; provides requirements & procedures for right of first refusal; authorizes certain developments of regional impact agreements to be amended. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 0060 County and Municipal Code Enforcement by Bradley

County and Municipal Code Enforcement; Prohibiting code inspectors designated by boards of county commissioners from initiating investigations of potential violations of codes and ordinances by way of anonymous complaints; prohibiting code inspectors from initiating enforcement proceedings for potential violations of codes and ordinances by way of anonymous complaints; prohibiting code enforcement officers from initiating investigations of potential violations of codes and ordinances by way of anonymous complaints; prohibiting code inspectors designated by governing bodies of municipalities from initiating investigations of potential violations of codes and ordinances by way of anonymous complaints; requiring persons who report potential violations of codes and ordinances to provide specified information to the governing body before an investigation occurs, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

HB 0067 Public Defender Duties by Fernandez-Barquin

Public Defender Duties: Specifies additional circumstances under which a public defender may not be appointed to represent a defendant. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 0070 Domestic Violence Centers by Garcia

Domestic Violence Centers; Prohibiting the unlawful disclosure of certain information about domestic violence centers; providing criminal penalties, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 0076 Insurance by Boyd

Insurance; Prohibiting certain practices by contractors; prohibiting a contractor from executing a contract with a residential property owner for a roofing repair or replacement unless certain notice is included; requiring property insurers, effective a certain date, to include certain data regarding closed claims in their annual reports to the Office of Insurance Regulation; requiring the Property Insurance Corporation

to include the costs of catastrophe reinsurance to its projected 100-year probable maximum loss in its rate calculations even if the corporation does not purchase such reinsurance, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 0088 Farming Operations by Brodeur

Farming Operations; Prohibiting farms from being held liable for certain claims for tort liability except under certain circumstances; providing a burden of proof; prohibiting nuisance actions from being filed against farm operations unless specified conditions are met; providing requirements for and limitations on damages; providing that plaintiffs who bring nuisance actions against farm operations are liable for certain costs and expenses under certain conditions, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 0096 Child Welfare by Book

Child Welfare; Transferring existing provisions relating to the central abuse hotline of the Department of Children and Families; providing criminal, civil, and administrative immunity to child protective investigators who report known or suspected animal cruelty; requiring the department to make available specified training for caregivers of children in out-of-home care; requiring the department to develop an alternative plan for providing community-based child welfare services under certain circumstances, etc. Effective Date: Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act, this act shall take effect July 1, 2021

SB 0100 Highway Projects by Harrell

Highway Projects; Repealing provisions relating to applications for funding for technical assistance relating to areas in and around a proposed multiuse corridor interchange; requiring that \$35 million transferred to Florida's Turnpike Enterprise be used for a specified purpose beginning in a specified fiscal year and annually for up to 30 years thereafter; requiring that certain increased revenues be used to fund specified projects beginning in a specified fiscal year and annually thereafter; requiring the department, in coordination with the Florida Turnpike Enterprise, to evaluate certain roadways for development of specific controlled access facilities and to include such projects in the work program, etc. Effective Date: Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act, this act shall take effect July 1, 2021

HB 0131 Educator Conduct by Duggan

Educator Conduct: Requiring DOE to maintain a disqualification list of individuals; revises provisions relating to employment & termination of public school & private school employees; revises duties of DOE, Commissioner of Education, school districts, & school principals relating to employee conduct & employment & termination of public school & private school employees. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0139 Motor Vehicle and Vessel Registration Data by Fernandez-Barquin

Motor Vehicle and Vessel Registration Data: Requires tax collectors or third parties contracted with tax collectors to enter into memorandum of understanding with DHSMV & make certain determinations; requires DHSMV to ensure certain technology used by tax collectors protects customer privacy & data; authorizes DHSMV to provide certain technology to tax collectors upon request in order to provide data access & uniform interface functionalities for registration renewal transactions; authorizes use of data & functionality for certain purposes; requires development of data access & uniform interface functionalities by certain date. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0141 Parenting and Time-Sharing of a Minor Child for a Convicted Parent by Leek

Parenting and Time-Sharing of a Minor Child for a Convicted Parent: Creates rebuttable presumption against shared parental responsibility & time-sharing with minor child for parents who have been convicted of or had adjudication withheld for specified offense. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 0146 Civic Literacy Education by Brandes

Civic Literacy Education; Requiring the Commissioner of Education to develop criteria for a civic literacy practicum that meets certain goals beginning in a specified school year; authorizing time spent on specified civic engagement activities to count toward requirements for certain scholarships and academic awards; establishing the Citizen Scholar Program within the University of South Florida, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 0148 Beverage Law by Bradley

Beverage Law; Authorizing certain food service establishments to sell or deliver certain alcoholic beverages for off-premises consumption under certain circumstances; providing requirements for such establishments to sell alcoholic beverages for off-premises consumption; requiring that such alcoholic beverages be transported in a specified manner; specifying that certain alcoholic beverages sold by such establishments are not open containers for the purposes of the prohibition on possessing open containers of alcoholic beverages in vehicles, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

HB 0149 Students with Disabilities in Public Schools by DuBose

Students with Disabilities in Public Schools: Prohibits use of seclusion on students; revises provisions relating to use of restraint on certain students; provides DOE, school district, school, & personnel requirements; provides for placement of video camera in specified classrooms; provides requirements for such placement; requires continuing education & inservice training for teaching students with emotional or behavioral disabilities. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0157 First Aid Training in Public Schools by Hawkins

First Aid Training in Public Schools: Revises grade levels that school districts are encouraged provide certain first aid training; requires school district provide specified grade levels with certain first aid training; provides requirements for such training. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0169 Purchase of Commodities and Services by Water Management Districts by Maggard

Purchase of Commodities and Services by Water Management Districts: Authorizes water management districts to purchase commodities & contractual services from purchasing contracts of specified entities; provides conditions for such purchases. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0173 Individual Education Plan Requirements for Students with Disabilities by Tant

Individual Education Plan Requirements for Students with Disabilities: Revises provision related to development and implementation of IEPs for students with disabilities regarding postsecondary education and career opportunities including such IEP requirements, timeline, information provided, & statement of intent; requires DOE Education to review specified services & programs; requires DOE to establish & publish uniform best practices for such services & programs. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0183 Office of Minority Health and Health Equity by Brown

Office of Minority Health and Health Equity: Requires Office of Minority Health & Health Equity to develop & promote statewide implementation of certain policies, programs, & practices; requires representative from each county health department to serve as minority health liaison; requires DOH to maintain specified information on its website; requires office to serve as liaison to & assist certain federal offices. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 0184 Purple Alert by Berman

Purple Alert; Requiring the Department of Law Enforcement, in cooperation with the Department of Transportation, the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles, the Department of the Lottery, and local law enforcement agencies, to establish and implement the Purple Alert; requiring the local law enforcement agency having jurisdiction to notify media and alert subscribers if a Purple Alert is determined to be necessary and appropriate; providing that the Department of Law Enforcement, as the Purple Alert coordinator, and certain agencies, employees, individuals, and entities are immune from civil liability for damages when performing certain actions in good faith, etc. APPROPRIATION: \$199,901 Effective Date: Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act and except for this section, which shall take effect July 1, 2021, this act shall take effect July 1, 2022

HB 0217 Conservation Area Designations by Hunschofsky

Conservation Area Designations: Designates Southeast Florida Coral Reef Ecosystem Conservation Area as Kristin Jacobs Coral Reef Ecosystem Conservation Area; directs DEP to erect suitable markers. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0221 Recovery of Spaceflight Assets by Sirois

Recovery of Spaceflight Assets: Provides spaceflight entity retains ownership of spaceflight asset after launch or upon reentry; requires person who finds item reasonably identifiable as spaceflight asset to report description & location to law enforcement; requires law enforcement to notify owner of spaceflight asset; authorizes owner of spaceflight asset to enter private property; prohibits person from appropriating spaceflight asset to his or her own use or refusing to surrender spaceflight asset to law enforcement or owner; provides criminal penalties. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0223 Marina Evacuations by Plasencia

Marina Evacuations: Prohibits vessels under specified weight from remaining in certain marinas that have been deemed unsuitable for refuge during hurricane after issuance of hurricane watch; requires marina owner, operator, employee, or agent to remove specified vessels; provides that such owner, operator, employee, or agent may charge vessel owner reasonable fee for such removal & may not be held liable for any damages as result of such removal; provides that owners or operators of certain vessels may be subject to fine that deepwater seaport issuing evacuation order may impose & collect. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0231 Services for Veterans and Their Families by Zika

Services for Veterans and Their Families: Authorizes DVA to establish Florida Veterans' Care Coordination Program to provide behavioral health care referral & care coordination services for veterans & their families; authorizes DVA to contract with certain nonprofit entity to enter into agreements with Florida 211 Network participants to provide such services; provides for statewide delivery of specified services by program teams; requires Florida 211 Network participants to collect program implementation data & submit such data to DVA; requires DVA to submit report to Governor & Legislature. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0233 Postsecondary Education by Roach

Postsecondary Education: Prohibits State Board of Education and BOG from shielding students, staff, and faculty from certain speech; requires State Board of Education to conduct annual assessment on intellectual freedom & viewpoint diversity; creates a cause of action for recording or publication of certain video or audio recordings; revises provisions related to protected expressive activity, university student governments, & codes of conduct. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0241 Parents' Bill of Rights by Byrd

Parents' Bill of Rights: Provides parental rights relating to a minor child's education, upbringing, & health care; provides school district, health care practitioner, hospital requirements & specified penalties. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0245 Massage Therapy by Chaney

Massage Therapy: Revises definition & purpose of massage therapy. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 0262 Dispensing Medicinal Drugs by Harrell

Dispensing Medicinal Drugs; Authorizing certain hospitals to dispense supplies of prescribed medicinal drugs in a specified amount to emergency department patients or inpatients upon discharge under certain circumstances; authorizing a greater specified supply of medicinal drugs to be prescribed and dispensed in areas in which a state of emergency has been declared and is in effect; authorizing a prescriber to provide a patient with a prescription for medicinal drugs beyond the initial prescription period under certain circumstances, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 0272 Rare Disease Advisory Council by Baxley

Rare Disease Advisory Council; Creating the advisory council adjunct to the Department of Health; specifying the purpose of the advisory council; defining the term "rare disease"; prescribing duties and responsibilities of the advisory council, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 0274 Juvenile Diversion Program Expunction by Perry

Juvenile Diversion Program Expunction; Requiring the Department of Law Enforcement to expunge the nonjudicial arrest record of certain minors who have successfully completed a diversion program for any offense, rather than only a misdemeanor offense; authorizing a minor who successfully completes a

diversion program for any offense, rather than only for a first-time misdemeanor offense, to lawfully deny or fail to acknowledge certain information, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 0286 Fire Sprinklers by Perry

Fire Sprinklers; Revising the definition of the term “Contractor V”; authorizing certain fire protection system contractors to design certain systems; revising the definition of the term “fire protection system”, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

HB 0311 Pub. Rec./Assessment Instruments by Silvers

Pub. Rec./Assessment Instruments: Expands examination & assessment instruments which are confidential & exempt from public record requirements; provides provisions governing access, maintenance, & destruction of certain instruments & related materials shall be prescribed by rules of State Board of Education and regulations of Board of Governors; provides for future legislative review & repeal; provides legislative findings; provides statement of public necessity. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 0342 Vehicle and Vessel Registration by Diaz

Vehicle and Vessel Registration; Authorizing tax collectors to determine service charges collected by privately owned license plate agents for motor vehicle titles; requiring that additional service charges be itemized and disclosed to the person paying them; requiring a license plate agent to enter into a contract with the tax collector for a certain purpose; requiring tax collectors and approved license plate agents to enter into a memorandum of understanding with the department for a certain purpose, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 0348 Medicaid by Rodriguez (A)

Medicaid; Revising the types of emergency transportation vehicle services provided to Medicare-eligible persons for which Medicaid shall pay deductibles and coinsurance; specifying that such payments must be made according to certain procedure codes, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

HB 0353 Bicycle Operation Regulations by Hage

Bicycle Operation Regulations: Providing an exception to the requirement that a person operating a bicycle ride upon or astride a seat attached thereto; revising construction relating to electric bicycle regulations, etc. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 0354 Restitution by Harrell

Restitution; Providing for the purposes of restitution in a criminal proceeding; specifying the standards for valuation of a restitution order; authorizing a court to consider hearsay evidence regarding valuation of a restitution award under certain circumstances; providing for the purposes of restitution in a delinquency proceeding; specifying the standards for valuation of a restitution order; authorizing a court to consider hearsay evidence regarding valuation of a restitution award under certain circumstances, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 0366 Educational Opportunities Leading to Employment by Hutson

Educational Opportunities Leading to Employment; Renaming the Florida Ready to Work Certification Program as the Florida Ready to Work Credential Program; providing where the program training may be conducted; requiring that certain students be covered by the workers’ compensation insurance of their employers in a work-based learning opportunity; requiring admissions counseling to use certain tests or alternative methods to measure achievement of college-level communication and computation by students entering college programs, etc. APPROPRIATION: \$2,000,000 Effective Date: 7/1/2021

HB 0369 Construction Contracting Regulation Exemption by Rodriguez (Ant)

Construction Contracting Regulation Exemption: Exempts from licensure a member of the Miccosukee Tribe of Indians of Florida or the Seminole Tribe of Florida when constructing specified structures. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 0378 Payment for Construction Services by Bradley

Payment for Construction Services; Increasing the interest rate for certain payments for purchases of

construction services; specifying that a person, firm, or corporation who fails to make certain payments relating to public projects commits a misapplication of construction funds and is subject to criminal penalties; increasing the interest rate for overdue payments for the purchase of construction services; expanding the list of actions for which a licensee may be disciplined by the Construction Industry Licensing Board; requiring the board to suspend certain licenses for a minimum period of time under certain circumstances, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

HB 0379 Pub. Rec./Economic Development Agencies by Giallombardo

Pub. Rec./Economic Development Agencies: Provides exemption from public records requirements for certain information held by economic development agency; provides that such information may be released in aggregated & anonymized format; provides for future legislative review & repeal of exemption; provides statement of public necessity. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 0388 Injured Police Canines by Wright

Injured Police Canines; Authorizing licensed life support services to transport injured police canines under certain circumstances; authorizing a paramedic or an emergency medical technician to provide emergency medical care to injured police canines under certain circumstances; providing for immunity from criminal and civil liability under certain circumstances, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 0400 Public Records by Rodrigues (R)

Public Records; Prohibiting an agency that receives a request to inspect or copy a record from responding to such request by filing an action for declaratory relief against the requester, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

HB 0401 Florida Building Code by Fetterhoff

Florida Building Code: Prohibiting certain regulations relating to building design elements from being applied to certain dwellings; providing exceptions; providing requirements for the petition and commission; requiring the commission to issue a nonbinding advisory opinion within a specified timeframe; prohibiting the use of preliminary maps issued by the Federal Emergency Management Agency under certain circumstances; authorizing the commission to issue errata to the code; prohibiting a local government from requiring certain contracts for the issuance of a building permit; authorizing certain local entities to use a private provider for code inspection services under certain circumstances; revising how certain excess funds may be used by a local government; requiring evaluation entities that meet certain criteria to comply with certain standards; authorizing the commission to suspend or revoke certain approvals under certain circumstances, etc. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0403 Home-based Businesses by Giallombardo

Home-based Businesses: Prohibiting local governments from taking certain actions relating to the licensure and regulation of home-based businesses; specifying conditions under which a business is considered a home-based business; authorizing home-based businesses to operate in areas zoned for residential use; specifying that home-based businesses are subject to certain business taxes; authorizing the prevailing party in such challenge to recover specified attorney fees and costs, etc. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0419 Early Learning and Early Grade Success by Grall

Early Learning and Early Grade Success: Deleting the Office of Early Learning from within the Office of Independent Education and Parental Choice of the Department of Education; establishing the Division of Early Learning within the department; revising approved child care or early education settings for the placement of certain children; revising the requirements of the Gold Seal Quality Care program; requiring students enrolled in the Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program to participate in a specified screening and progress monitoring program; revising early learning coalition responsibilities and duties; authorizing certain students who enrolled in the Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program to receive intensive reading interventions using specified funds, etc. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 0420 Motor Vehicle Insurance Coverage Exclusions by Hooper

Motor Vehicle Insurance Coverage Exclusions; Providing that private passenger motor vehicle policies

may exclude certain coverages for claims resulting from the operation of motor vehicles by identified individuals under certain circumstances; requiring excluded drivers to meet certain requirements for financial responsibility, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

HB 0429 Purple Star Campuses by Learned

Purple Star Campuses: Requires DOE establish Purple Star Campus program; specifies program criteria for participating schools; authorizes schools to partner with school districts to meet criteria. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 0430 Retail Petroleum Fuel Measuring Devices by Rodriguez (A)

Retail Petroleum Fuel Measuring Devices; Revising the types of certain security measures required to be affixed to or installed onto retail petroleum fuel measuring devices; requiring owners or operators of retail petroleum fuel measuring devices to affix to or install onto the measuring devices certain security measures by a specified date; authorizing the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services to take certain retail petroleum fuel measuring devices out of service until compliance is restored; preempting the regulation of petroleum fuel measuring devices to the state, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

HB 0431 Physician Assistants by Rommel

Physician Assistants: Revising legislative intent; defining and redefining terms; revising a limitation on the number of physician assistants a physician may supervise at one time; deleting a requirement that a physician assistant inform his or her patients that they have the right to see a physician before the physician assistant prescribes or dispenses a prescription; authorizing physician assistants to procure drugs and medical devices; revising requirements for a certain formulary; authorizing physician assistants to authenticate documents that may be authenticated by a physician, etc. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0435 Veterans Employment and Training by Sirois

Veterans Employment and Training: Directs Florida Is For Veterans, Inc., to serve as state's principal assistance organization under United States Department of Defense's SkillBridge program; prescribes duties of corporation to facilitate administration of SkillBridge program. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0441 Elder-focused Dispute Resolution Process by Hage

Elder-focused Dispute Resolution Process: Authorizes courts to appoint eldercaring coordinators & refer parties to eldercaring coordination; specifies duration of appointments; requires courts to conduct review hearings; provides for qualifications, disqualifications, removal, & suspension of coordinators; authorizes courts to award certain fees & costs of eldercaring coordination; provides immunity from liability for certain parties; requires Florida Supreme Court to establish minimum standards & procedures. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0463 Community Association Pools by Roach

Community Association Pools: Exempts certain homeowners' & other property association pools from supervision by DOH; provides that such pools are subject to certain civil enforcement. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0467 Insurance Adjuster Examination Requirements by DuBose

Insurance Adjuster Examination Requirements: Exempts certain applicants for licensure as all-lines adjusters from required examination. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0487 Growth Management by Duggan

Growth Management: Authorizing landowners with development orders existing before the incorporation of a municipality to elect to abandon such orders and develop the vested density and intensity contained therein under specified conditions; providing an exception to a prohibition against legal entities and their members exercising the power of eminent domain over or acquiring title to certain facilities or property; revising the required acreage thresholds for adopting an amendment using a small scale development amendment, etc. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0519 Required Health Education Instruction by Yarborough

Required Health Education Instruction: Provides additional requirements for health education; revises grades when students receive certain health education instruction; requires health education instruction include prevention of specified harms. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 0524 Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission Trust Funds by Hooper

Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission Trust Funds; Revising the sources of funds that may be used for specified purposes for the Florida Panther Research and Management Trust Fund; authorizing the commission to invest and reinvest funds and the interest thereof of the Marine Resources Conservation Trust Fund and the Nongame Wildlife Trust Fund, respectively; revising the use of such funds for the marketing of the license plates; authorizing such funds to be used for commission administrative costs, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

HB 0529 Moments of Silence in Public Schools by Fine

Moments of Silence in Public Schools: Requires principals to require teachers to set aside time for moment of silence; prohibits teachers from making suggestions to nature of any reflection during moment of silence; deletes provision authorizing district school boards to provide brief period of silent prayer or meditation; requires certain teachers encourage parents or guardians to discuss moment of silence & make suggestions as to the best use of this time. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 0530 Nonopioid Alternatives by Perry

Nonopioid Alternatives; Authorizing certain health care practitioners to provide a specified educational pamphlet to patients in an electronic format, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

HB 0545 Reproductive Health and Disease Education by Chaney

Reproductive Health and Disease Education: Requires each school district to publish notice on district's website concerning parent's right to exempt student from reproductive health & disease education; requires district school boards to annually approve instructional materials relating to reproductive health & disease education in an open, noticed public meeting; specifies that reproductive health & disease education instructional materials are to be made available for public review & comment under specific process. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0583 Interception of Wire, Oral, or Electronic Communications Made in Violation of Protective Orders by Joseph

Interception of Wire, Oral, or Electronic Communications Made in Violation of Protective Orders: Provides exception to prohibitions on interception & recording of communications when communication is received in violation of specified injunction or order; limits use of intercepted communication to evidencing violation of specified injunction or order. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 0590 School Safety by Harrell

School Safety; Revising parent, guardian, or caregiver notification requirements that must be met before an involuntary examination of a minor; requiring a principal or his or her designee who successfully notifies any known emergency contact to share only the information necessary to alert such contact that the parent or caregiver must be contacted; requiring codes of student conduct to include provisions relating to civil citation or similar prearrest diversion programs for specified purposes; revising training requirements for school safety officers, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

HB 0597 Homestead Exemption for Seniors 65 and Older by Woodson

Homestead Exemption for Seniors 65 and Older: Revises provisions to require certain taxpayers to submit claim for homestead exemption only one time if certain conditions are met; deletes provision related to submission of supporting documentation for exemption renewal; requires property appraiser to provide specified information related to income limitations on annual basis. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 0616 Public Accountancy by Gruters

Public Accountancy; Requiring that certain applicants not be licensed in any state or territory in order to be licensed by endorsement; providing license renewal requirements for nonresident licensees; requiring that a majority of the hours required for continuing education include specific content, etc.

SB 0628 Urban Agriculture by Rouson

Urban Agriculture; Authorizing farm equipment used to transport farm products to be stored, maintained, or repaired within specified boundaries; exempting farm equipment used in urban agriculture from provisions requiring farm equipment to be located within specified boundaries; providing that nonresidential farm buildings, fences, or signs located on lands used for urban agriculture are not exempt from the Florida Building Code or local governmental regulations; creating the "Urban Agriculture Pilot Project Act"; authorizing the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services to approve municipal urban agricultural pilot projects, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 0630 Community Associations by Baxley

Community Associations; Prohibiting insurance policies from providing specified rights of subrogation under certain circumstances; authorizing a condominium association to extinguish discriminatory restrictions; authorizing the board of administration of an association to take certain actions relating to electric vehicle charging stations and natural gas fuel stations; authorizing parties to initiate presuit mediation under certain circumstances; revising the allowable uses of certain escrow funds withdrawn by developers; authorizing certain developers to include reserves in the budget, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

HB 0649 Petition for Objection to Assessment by Fernandez-Barquin

Petition for Objection to Assessment: Specifies requirements for content, delivery, & posting of certain association notices; provides that certain associations have right to seek judicial review, appeal decisions, & represent unit or parcel owners in certain proceedings; requires certain associations to defend unit or parcel owners in certain proceedings; provides that individual unit or parcel owners do not have to be named as defendants in certain proceedings; revises parties considered defendants in tax suit; provides options to unit or parcel owners for defending tax suit; specifies conditions for releasing unit or parcel owner from lis pendens related to certain actions; authorizes condominium association to take certain actions relating to challenge to ad valorem taxes. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0667 Building Inspections by Mooney, Jr.

Building Inspections: Requires certain counties & enforcement agencies allow requests for inspections to be submitted electronically; provides acceptable methods of electronic submission; authorizes enforcement agencies to perform virtual inspections; requires refund of fees in certain circumstances; requires surcharges be recalculated under certain conditions. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0673 DNA Evidence Collected in Sexual Offense Investigations by Slosberg

DNA Evidence Collected in Sexual Offense Investigations: Requires FDLE to create & maintain statewide database for tracking sexual offense evidence kits; provides database requirements; requires FDLE to ensure that alleged sexual offense victims & certain other persons are notified of or have access to information regarding such kits & evidence; provides requirements for such notification. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 0694 Waste Management by Rodrigues (R)

Waste Management; Requiring the Department of Environmental Protection to review and update its report on retail bags and submit the updated report to the Legislature by a specified date; requiring a local government to pay a specified amount of compensation to a displaced private waste company at the end of a specified notice period; removing a provision authorizing a local government to pay a specified amount of compensation to a private waste company as an alternative to delaying displacement for a specified period; defining the term "storm-generated yard trash", etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 0714 Resource Information for Individuals with Disabilities by Taddeo

Resource Information for Individuals with Disabilities; Requiring the Agency for Persons with Disabilities to provide specified information to persons applying for certain waiver services; requiring the agency to

provide a certain disclosure statement along with such information; requiring the agency to publish such information and statement on its website and provide such information and statement to certain persons annually, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 0716 **Consent for Pelvic Examinations** by Book

Consent for Pelvic Examinations; Revising the definition of the term “pelvic examination”; revising the circumstances under which a pelvic examination may be performed without consent; providing that certain health care practitioners and students need only obtain written consent for the initial pelvic examination for certain patients under certain circumstances; requiring such written consent form to inform the patient that multiple pelvic examinations may be conducted during the course of care and treatment, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

HB 0723 **Juvenile Justice Education Programs** by Massullo, Jr.

Juvenile Justice Education Programs: Increases percentage of certain funds that must be spent on specified costs; requires contracts between district school boards & juvenile justice education programs be in writing; requires DOE provide mediation services for certain disputes; prohibits school boards from delaying certain payments pending receipt of local funds. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 0728 **Credit for Reinsurance** by Broxson

Credit for Reinsurance; Transferring specified authority and duties relating to credit for reinsurance from the Commissioner of Insurance to the Office of Insurance Regulation; revising the attorney designation requirement in reinsurance agreements with certain assuming insurers under certain circumstances; specifying requirements for assuming insurers and reinsurance agreements; authorizing a ceding insurer or its representative that is subject to rehabilitation, liquidation, or conservation to seek a certain court order; providing construction, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

HB 0735 **Preemption of Local Occupational Licensing** by Harding

Preemption of Local Occupational Licensing: Preempts licensing of occupations to state; prohibits local governments from imposing or modifying licensing requirements; specifies certain local licensing may not be enforced; specifies certain specialty contractors are not required to register with Construction Industry Licensing Board; prohibits local governments from requiring certain specialty contractors to obtain license; specifies job scopes for which local government may not require license; authorizes counties & municipalities to issue journeyman licenses. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 0768 **Administration of Vaccines** by Baxley

Administration of Vaccines; Revising the specified immunizations or vaccines that certified pharmacists and registered interns may administer to adults; authorizing certain pharmacists to administer influenza vaccines to individuals 7 years of age or older under certain circumstances, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

HB 0781 **Public Records** by Robinson (W)

Public Records: Prohibits county recorder from removing grantor, grantee, or party name from register of Official Records & index under certain conditions; prescribes requirements for person claiming public records exemption; authorizes release of restricted information to certain entities whose information was removed; authorizes disclosure of exempt information to specified parties; provides criminal penalties; requires that request to maintain exempt status be notarized; prescribes procedures for removal of exempt information; provides that exempt status of home address contained in Official Records is maintained only during certain period; prescribes procedures to release protected decedent's removed information; requires daily schedule of deeds & conveyances to include notification of any information therein which is subject to request for removal. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 0794 **Independent Living Services** by Bean

Independent Living Services; Removing a provision requiring the Florida Independent Living Council to assist the Division of Blind Services of the Department of Education; requiring the council to coordinate with centers for independent living; prohibiting the council from engaging in certain activities; requiring the council to comply with state and federal laws and regulations relating to lobbying; increasing the percentage of certain revenues used to administer the James Patrick Memorial Work Incentive Personal Attendant Services and Employment Assistance Program, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

HB 0797 Florida Life and Health Insurance Guaranty Association by Robinson (W)

Florida Life and Health Insurance Guaranty Association: Redefines "person," to apply to provisions relating to life & health insurance guaranty of payments; authorizes Florida Life & Health Insurance Guaranty Association to assume, reissue, & cause to be reissued covered policies of impaired insurers; revises association's standing before court; provides association has right to appear or intervene before court or agency in another state; authorizes board of directors of association to credit specified assessments against certain future assessments; requires member insurers to pay deferred assessments. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 0804 Substance Abuse Services by Harrell

Substance Abuse Services; Providing criminal penalties for making certain false representations or omissions of material facts when applying for service provider licenses; requiring the Department of Children and Families to suspend a service provider's license under certain circumstances; expanding the applicability of certain exemptions for disqualification to applications for certification of a recovery residence or a recovery residence administrator, respectively; specifying that certain dwellings converted to recovery residences do not have a change of occupancy under the Florida Building Code due to such conversion, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

HB 0805 Volunteer Ambulance Services by Caruso

Volunteer Ambulance Services: Authorizing certain medical staff of a volunteer ambulance service to use red lights on a privately owned vehicle under certain circumstances; authorizing vehicles of volunteer ambulance services to show or display red lights and operate emergency lights and sirens under certain circumstances; authorizing privately owned vehicles belonging to certain medical staff of a volunteer ambulance service to display or use red warning signals under certain circumstances; providing that county and municipal governments may not limit, prohibit, or prevent volunteer ambulance services from responding to emergencies or providing emergency medical services or transport within their respective jurisdictions, etc. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0823 Alarm System Contractors by Mariano

Alarm System Contractors: Provides that advertisements for alarm system contracting do not have to include contractor's registration or certification number; authorizes contractor to begin repairing specified fire alarm system under certain conditions; provides that repaired fire alarm system is not compliant with applicable codes & standards until certain conditions are met. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0827 School District Funding by Hawkins

School District Funding: Requires school districts allocate certain amount of specified funds to programs that prepare students to enroll in AICE courses; requires such funds be spent on specified costs; requires school districts to distribute specified bonuses to certain teachers providing pre-AICE instruction; requires bonuses based on student's score on AICE examination to be paid to all AICE teachers. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0847 Florida Postsecondary Academic Library Network by Byrd

Florida Postsecondary Academic Library Network: Deletes provisions for Florida Academic Services Library Services Cooperative and Complete Florida Plus Program; revises provisions for statewide Internet-based catalog & online student advising services; provides duties for the Florida Postsecondary Academic Library Network. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0855 Barber Services by Morales

Barber Services: Authorizes barber to shampoo, cut, or arrange hair in location other than registered barbershop without specified arrangements. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0871 Sovereign Immunity for Child Protection Teams by Snyder

Sovereign Immunity for Child Protection Teams: Revises term "officer, employee, or agent" as it applies to immunity from personal liability to include members of Child Protection Teams in certain circumstances. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0873 **Military Affairs** by Giallombardo

Military Affairs: Revises provisions relating to military positions in certain employment classes & officer appointments; requires Adjutant General to serve as Commanding General of militia; establishes Florida Code of Military Justice (FCMJ); authorizes courts-martial to try Florida National Guard members for offenses punishable by FCMJ; revises provisions relating to courts-martial & punishments adjudged thereby; authorizes military judge to issue pretrial confinement warrants & subpoenas; revises membership, terms, & meeting requirements of Armory Board; provides members of Florida National Guard are subject to FCMJ regardless of status; revises circumstances under which physician may practice medicine during emergency, disaster, or federal military training. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0885 **Juvenile Justice Programs and Detention** by Plasencia

Juvenile Justice Programs and Detention: Creates Accountability & Program Support Program within DJJ; requires court to consider specified information before ordering child into custody for failing to appear; requires each judicial circuit to develop plan in consultation with parties; requires DJJ to calculate annually & provide to each county that is not fiscally constrained & does not provide its own detention care for juveniles its annual percentage share of detention costs; authorizes DJJ to evaluate viability of alternative model for providing & funding education services for youth in detention & residential facilities. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 0896 **Renewable Energy** by Brodeur

Renewable Energy; Defining the term “solar facility”; providing that solar facilities are a permitted use in local government comprehensive plan agricultural land use categories and certain agricultural zoning districts; authorizing the Florida Public Service Commission to approve cost recovery by a gas public utility for certain contracts for the purchase of renewable natural gas, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 0904 **Doorstep Refuse and Recycling Collection Containers** by Diaz

Doorstep Refuse and Recycling Collection Containers; Deleting an obsolete provision; removing the scheduled repeal of certain provisions regulating the use of containers in exit access corridors, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

HB 0905 **Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly** by Rommel

Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly: Authorizing the Agency for Health Care Administration, in consultation with the Department of Elderly Affairs, to approve entities applying to deliver PACE services in the state; requiring applications to be reviewed and considered on a continuous basis; requiring notice of applications to be published in the Florida Administrative Register; providing specified application requirements for such prospective PACE organizations; requiring the agency to oversee and monitor the PACE program and organizations; providing that a PACE organization is exempt from certain requirements, etc. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0909 **Cultural and Historical Programs** by Sirois

Cultural and Historical Programs: Designates Museum of Florida History as official state history museum; renames Division of Cultural Affairs as Division of Arts & Culture; transfers certain responsibilities from Division of Cultural Affairs to Division of Historical Resources; revises provisions relating to Museum of Florida History museum store; provides for disposition of abandoned property. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 0919 **Preemption Over Restriction of Utility Services** by Tomkow

Preemption Over Restriction of Utility Services: Prohibits municipalities, counties, special districts, or other political subdivisions from restricting or prohibiting types or fuel sources of energy production used, delivered, converted, or supplied by certain entities to customers; voids existing specified documents & policies that are preempted by this act. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 0920 **Liability of Persons Providing Areas for Public Outdoor Recreational Purposes** by Bradley

Liability of Persons Providing Areas for Public Outdoor Recreational Purposes; Providing that owners may not be subject to liability if they are generating certain revenues and those revenues are used

exclusively for specified purposes; expanding the applicability of the limitation of liability for persons who provide areas to the public for outdoor recreational purposes without charge, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 0922 **Veterans' Preference in Employment** by Burgess

Veterans' Preference in Employment; Authorizing the state and its political subdivisions to waive certain postsecondary educational requirements for employment for servicemembers and veterans who meet specified criteria; revising the list of positions that are exempt from veterans' preference requirements; requiring, rather than authorizing, each political subdivision to develop and implement a veterans' recruitment plan for specified purposes; modifying point preferences given to veterans and their family members when a numerically based selection process is used for hiring, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 0950 **Bicycle and Pedestrian Safety** by Book

Bicycle and Pedestrian Safety; Revising and providing requirements for the driver of a motor vehicle overtaking a bicycle or other nonmotorized vehicle or an electric bicycle; providing exceptions; providing a penalty; requiring the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to provide an annual awareness and safety campaign regarding certain safety precautions; exempting a motor vehicle driver from certain provisions relating to no-passing zones when overtaking a bicycle or other nonmotorized vehicle or an electric bicycle; making a technical change; revising requirements for vehicles turning at intersections; prohibiting persons riding bicycles in a bicycle lane from riding more than two abreast, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 0976 **Protection of Ecological Systems** by Brodeur

Protection of Ecological Systems; Creating the "Florida Wildlife Corridor Act"; requiring the Department of Environmental Protection to take certain actions to support the Florida wildlife corridor; requiring the St. Johns River Water Management District, in consultation with the Department of Environmental Protection, Seminole County, the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, and the Department of Transportation, to issue a report that includes information and updates regarding the implementation of recommendations from the Little Wekiva Watershed Management Plan Final Report dated November 2005 by a specified date; requiring the Department of Environmental Protection and the water management district to review certain permits along the Little Wekiva River, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 1018 **Largemouth Bass** by Boyd

Largemouth Bass; Requiring the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, in consultation with specified entities, to adopt a rule requiring certain facilities to maintain stock acquisition documentation or records of genetic testing related to Florida largemouth bass; authorizing the sale of Florida largemouth bass as food fish under certain circumstances, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 1028 **Education** by Hutson

Education; Authorizing members of certain committees of a district school board to attend meetings in person or through the use of telecommunications networks; authorizing state universities and Florida College System institutions to solicit applications and sponsor charter schools under certain circumstances; authorizing a charter school to offer a career and professional academy; creating the "Fairness in Women's Sports Act"; expanding eligibility to receive capital outlay funds to schools of hope operated by a hope operator; authorizing the principal, teachers, and parent or guardian to collaborate to develop a customized 1-year education plan for the student in lieu of retaining the student, etc. Effective Date: Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act and except for this section, which shall take effect upon becoming a law, this act shall take effect July 1, 2021

HB 1041 **Protection of Elderly Persons and Disabled Adults** by Burton

Protection of Elderly Persons and Disabled Adults: Adds offenses to authority of Office of Statewide Prosecution; provides person convicted of abuse, neglect, or exploitation of elderly person or disabled adult is not qualified to act as personal representative; provides for forfeiture of specified benefits of persons convicted of offenses concerning elderly persons or disabled adults; provides persons convicted of offenses concerning elderly persons or disabled adults may still retain inheritance, survivorship rights, other rights, or trust interest if victim executes specified instrument; specifies

additional conduct that constitutes abuse or exploitation of elderly person or disabled adult; revises provisions concerning injunctions for protection; provides for extension of ex parte temporary injunctions. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 1048 Public Records/Conviction Integrity Unit Reinvestigation Information by Bean

Public Records/Conviction Integrity Unit Reinvestigation Information; Providing a public records exemption for certain conviction integrity unit reinvestigation information; providing for the future review and repeal of the exemption; providing a statement of public necessity, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

HB 1051 Environmental Compliance Costs by Fernandez-Barquin

Environmental Compliance Costs: Redefines term "environmental compliance costs" to include costs or expenses prudently incurred by an electric utility in complying with specified reclaimed water reuse requirements. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 1057 Agency for Health Care Administration by Garrison

Agency for Health Care Administration: Removes certain reporting requirements applicable to AHCA, certain requirements for Medicaid Pharmaceutical & Therapeutics Committee, & provisions relating to agency's implementation of prescribed-drug spending-control program & Organ Transplant Advisory Council. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 1060 Limitation of Liability for Voluntary Engineering or Architectural Services by Bradley

Limitation of Liability for Voluntary Engineering or Architectural Services; Defining the term "structures specialist"; exempting engineers, architects, and structures specialists from liability for certain voluntary engineering or architectural services under certain circumstances, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 1070 Estates and Trusts by Berman

Estates and Trusts; Requiring the court to allow an officer to elect to post and maintain a certain bond; providing that certain provisions of a will are void upon dissolution of marriage; specifying that a trust director submits to specified personal jurisdiction by accepting appointment as a trust director; creating the "Community Property Trust Act"; providing that certain property held in a community property trust qualifies as homestead property, etc. Effective Date: Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act and except for this section, which shall take effect upon this act becoming a law, this act shall take effect July 1, 2021

HB 1079 Agency Contracts for Commodities and Contractual Services by Mariano

Agency Contracts for Commodities and Contractual Services: Provides agency must issue request for quote to certain approved vendors when it issues request for quote for contractual services; provides for disqualification of firms or individuals from state term contract eligibility; provides qualification requirements for contract negotiator certification; provides for continuing oversight team; prohibits contract document for contractual services from containing nondisclosure clause. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 1086 Operation and Safety of Motor Vehicles and Vessels by Hutson

Operation and Safety of Motor Vehicles and Vessels; Revising conditions under which a person's driving privilege is suspended and under which the person commits a misdemeanor relating to tests for alcohol, chemical substances, or controlled substances; requiring the clerk of the court to notify the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles of certain final dispositions by electronic transmission; providing circumstances under which a person may operate a human-powered vessel within the boundaries of the marked channel of the Florida Intracoastal Waterway; designating Monroe County as an anchoring limitation area subject to certain requirements; authorizing a county or municipality to establish a boating-restricted area within and around a public mooring field and within certain portions of the Florida Intracoastal Waterway, etc. Effective Date: Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act, this act shall take effect July 1, 2021

SB 1108 Education by Diaz

Education; Authorizing the Department of Education to hold patents, copyrights, trademarks, and service marks; establishing the Innovative Blended Learning and Real-Time Student Assessment Pilot

Program within the department; requiring certain students to take a specified assessment relating to civic literacy; requiring certain postsecondary students to complete a civic literacy course and pass a specified assessment to demonstrate competency in civic literacy; requiring school districts to provide the SAT or ACT to grade 11 students beginning in a specified school year, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 1120 Telephone Solicitation by Gibson

Telephone Solicitation; Prohibiting certain telephonic sales calls without the prior express written consent of the called party; removing provisions authorizing the use of certain automated telephone dialing systems; providing a cause of action for aggrieved called parties; prohibiting a commercial telephone seller or salesperson from using automated dialing or recorded messages to make certain commercial telephone solicitation phone calls, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 1126 Department of Transportation by Harrell

Department of Transportation; Repealing a provision relating to applications for funding for technical assistance relating to areas in and around a proposed multiuse corridor interchange; clarifying that the Department of Revenue is responsible for a certain transfer from the State Treasury to the General Revenue Fund of a portion of documentary stamp tax distributions credited to the State Transportation Trust Fund; revising a limitation on an annual transfer from the State Transportation Trust Fund to the Right-of-Way Acquisition and Bridge Construction Trust Fund; requiring drivers to change lanes when approaching a road and bridge maintenance or construction vehicle displaying warning lights on the roadside without advance signs and channelizing devices; deleting a requirement that the department provide space and video conference capability at each of the department's district offices as an alternative to physical appearance by a person requesting a hearing before the Commercial Motor Vehicle Review Board within the department, etc. Effective Date: Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act, this act shall take effect July 1, 2021

SB 1134 Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles by Harrell

Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles; Revising regulations applicable to owners and drivers of commercial motor vehicles; revising the length of time within which an officer is authorized to give written notice requiring correction of an unduly hazardous operating condition; providing that owners and drivers of nonpublic sector buses operated on public highways of this state are subject to specified provisions of law; authorizing the department to conduct investigations and examinations of department-authorized private rebuilt inspection providers, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 1136 Board of Directors of Florida ABLE, Inc. by Rodrigues (R)

Board of Directors of Florida ABLE, Inc.; Revising the composition of the membership of the Florida ABLE, Inc., board of directors; removing a limit on the number of terms that certain reappointed members may serve, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

HB 1137 Information Technology Procurement by Fabricio

Information Technology Procurement: Requires DMS to establish project management & oversight standards for state agency compliance & perform project oversight on IT projects; requires agency to issue request for quote to certain vendors approved to provide commodities or services; requires DMS to prequalify firms & individuals to provide services on state term contract. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 1157 Freestanding Emergency Departments by Koster

Freestanding Emergency Departments: Prohibits hospital-based off-campus emergency department from holding itself out to public as urgent care center; requires such departments to post signs containing specified statements; provides requirements for advertisement of such departments; requires AHCA & health insurers to post & annually update certain information on their websites. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 1159 Education by Busatta Cabrera

Education: Authorizing a parent or guardian to request that his or her K-5 student be retained in a grade level for academic reasons for a specified school year; requiring that such a request be submitted in a specified manner; requiring school principals to consider such requests if they are timely received; authorizing school principals to consider requests that are not timely received; requiring a school

principal who considers a request for retention to inform the student's teachers of the request and collaboratively discuss with the parent or guardian any basis for agreement or disagreement with the request; requiring the Commissioner of Education to provide learning growth data calculated in accordance with a certain formula to each school district by a specified date each year; revising the minimum qualifications for part-time and full-time nondegreed teachers of career programs; revising the criteria for the Department of Education to issue a professional certificate; revising the goals of the program, etc. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 1189 **Victims of Sexual Offenses** by Fine

Victims of Sexual Offenses: Requires county health departments to participate in sexual assault response teams coordinated by certified rape crisis centers; authorizes establishment of teams by certified rape crisis centers; provides for duties & membership of sexual assault response teams; requires FL Council Against Sexual Violence to provide specified technical assistance; requires sexual assault response teams to promote & support use of sexual assault forensic examiners meeting certain requirements; requires Criminal Justice Standards & Training Commission to establish minimum standards for basic skills & continued education training programs for law enforcement officers that include specified response to sexual assault; provides requirements for courses & law enforcement officers; requires officer's certification to be placed on inactive status for failure to complete certain training. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 1194 **Transportation** by Hooper

Transportation; Authorizing governing bodies of municipalities and counties to abandon and convey their interests in certain roads and rights-of-way dedicated in a recorded residential subdivision plat to community development districts under specified conditions; providing that certain governmental entities may not prohibit certain vendors from responding to competitive solicitations of certain contractual services; revising provisions authorizing vehicles and equipment to show or display flashing lights; prohibiting the Department of Transportation and contractors and subcontractors of the department from purchasing specified substances from a borrow pit unless specified conditions are satisfied, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

HB 1197 **Courts** by Aloupis, Jr.

Courts: Revises requirements for storage of DCA & Supreme Court materials; requires specified entities to prepare plan to develop electronic solution for identifying assessments; provides periodic inflationary adjustment of monetary jurisdictional limit for county court actions; requires EDR to calculate & certify jurisdictional limit; requires specified entities to post on their websites such adjusted jurisdictional limit; requires DCA clerks to have office at headquarters; authorizes person summoned for jury service to postpone such service in event of emergency; authorizes electronic fingerprinting for certain offenses; removes requirement defendant's social security number be obtained at time of fingerprinting. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 1209 **Department of Financial Services** by Fetterhoff

Department of Financial Services: Requires State Risk Management Trust Fund to provide insurance for certain firefighter cancer-related benefits; prohibits unlicensed persons from acting as or advertising themselves as funeral directors, embalmers, direct disposers, or preneed sales agents unless they are so licensed; authorizes licensed funeral director interns & licensed combination funeral director & embalmer interns to continue performing certain tasks while transitioning to licensed funeral directors & licensed combination funeral director & embalmers; requires monument retailers to comply with specified requirements relating to place of business & operations; subjecting monument retailers to inspection; prohibits firesafety inspector from knowingly & intentionally requesting, soliciting, accepting, or agreeing to accept compensation offered to induce violation of certain codes, rules, or laws; provides that certain persons serving as volunteer firefighters may serve as regular or permanent firefighters for limited period; prohibits aiding or abetting of unlicensed activity of bail bond agent or temporary bail bond agent. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 1229 **Public Records** by Persons-Mulicka

Public Records: Requiring each county recorder or clerk of the court to make publicly available on an Internet website the identity of a respondent against whom a final judgment for an injunction for the protection of a minor is entered, as well as the fact that the final judgment injunction for the protection of

a minor has been entered; requiring each county recorder or clerk of the court to post a certain notice on the Internet website and in the office of the county recorder or clerk of the court; authorizing certain persons to petition the circuit court for compliance; requiring that final judgments for injunctions for protection be recorded in official records, etc. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 1231 Domestic Violence by Melo

Domestic Violence: Adds nonresidential outreach services to list of services certified domestic violence centers must provide; provides funding requirements for certified domestic violence; revises program content requirements for batterers' intervention programs; requires department to adopt certain rules. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 1239 Broadband Internet Infrastructure by Tomkow

Broadband Internet Infrastructure; Revising duties of the Florida Office of Broadband; providing an appropriation to the Department of Economic Opportunity for geographic information system broadband mapping; providing for administration of the program; providing requirements for grant awards; requiring the publication of certain information related to grant applications and grant awards on a website; requiring the office to publish specified information annually on its website; establishing a promotional rate and related terms for wireline attachments of broadband facilities to municipal electric utility poles; providing procedures and requirements for receiving the promotional rates; establishing cost responsibility for replacement utility poles in certain circumstances; prohibiting municipal electric utilities from increasing certain fees for pole attachments for a specified period, etc. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 1261 Higher Education by Toledo

Higher Education: Prohibits certain educational institutions from being civilly liable for certain actions; requires state university to waive certain tuition & fees for certain students who meet specified criteria; revises eligibility criteria for specified grant program. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 1289 Autonomous Vehicles by McFarland

Autonomous Vehicles: Authorizes operation of low-speed autonomous delivery vehicle on certain streets & roads; authorizes operation of low-speed autonomous delivery vehicle on streets or roads with posted speed limit of up to 45 miles per hour under specified conditions; provides requirements for low-speed autonomous delivery vehicles; provides certain fully autonomous vehicles are not subject to certain provisions of law or regulations. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 1297 Cybersecurity by Giallombardo

Cybersecurity: Requires audit plans of inspector general to include certain information; revises provisions to replace references to IT & computer security with references to cybersecurity; provides & revises requirements for DMS, acting through Florida Digital Service; creates Florida Cybersecurity Advisory Council within DMS; providing purpose of council. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 1313 Digital Driver Licenses and Identification Cards by LaMarca

Digital Driver Licenses and Identification Cards: Requires DHSMV to establish secure & uniform system for issuing optional digital proofs of driver licenses & identification cards; authorizes DHSMV to contract with one or more private entities to develop electronic credentialing system & other purposes; prohibits private entities from storing, selling, or sharing personal information collected from scanning digital proofs of driver licenses & identification cards. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 1349 Assistance Programs by Aloupis, Jr.

Assistance Programs: Requires early learning coalition to give priority for participation in school readiness program to certain children; requires Office of Early Learning within DOE to coordinate with University of Florida Anita Zucker Center for Excellence in Early Childhood Studies to conduct analysis of certain assistance programs; requires DCF to provide certain assistance. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 1381 Maternal Health Outcomes by Brown

Maternal Health Outcomes: Revises DOH's duties under Closing the Gap grant program; revises requirements for Closing the Gap grant proposals; requires DOH to establish telehealth minority maternity care pilot programs in specified counties by specified date; provides for funding of pilot

programs. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 1507 Workforce Related Programs and Services by Yarborough

Workforce Related Programs and Services: Creates Office of Reimagining Education and Career Help; creates & revises provisions relating to workforce services including the Labor Market Estimating Conference, workforce opportunity portal, state board composition, Credentials Review Committee, state plan requirements, waivers, local workforce development boards, Master Credentials List, CAPE Industry Certification Funding List, industry certifications, SEAS program, workforce development metrics, Florida Talent Development Council, Open Door Grant Program, preapprenticeship & apprenticeship program grants, Money-back Guarantee Program, automated consumer-first workforce system, career & education planning courses, digital credential courses, & student career service centers. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 1634 Public Records/Aquaculture/Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services by Brodeur

Public Records/Aquaculture/Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services; Providing a public records exemption for certain aquaculture records held by the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services; providing that the records may be disclosed to other governmental entities under certain circumstances; providing for retroactive application of the exemption; providing for future legislative review and repeal under the Open Government Sunset Review Act; providing a statement of public necessity, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 1716 Transportation Facility Designations Honoring Fallen Law Enforcement Officers by Hooper

Transportation Facility Designations Honoring Fallen Law Enforcement Officers; Providing honorary designations of certain transportation facilities in specified counties; directing the Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 1770 Genetic Counseling by Jones

Genetic Counseling; Creating the "Genetic Counseling Workforce Act"; providing licensure, licensure renewal, and continuing education requirements; requiring the Department of Health to adopt by rule continuing education requirements; prohibiting the licensing of a genetic counselor from being contingent on his or her participation in counseling that conflicts with his or her deeply held moral or religious beliefs; revising the definition of the term "health care practitioner" to include licensed genetic counselors, etc. APPROPRIATION: \$45,964 Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 1826 Human Trafficking by Diaz

Human Trafficking; Providing that a communication between a human trafficking victim advocate or trained volunteer and a human trafficking victim is confidential in certain circumstances; prohibiting a person from engaging in specified criminal acts relating to human trafficking with an adult believed to be a child younger than 18 years of age; prohibiting a clerk of the court from charging certain fees for petitions for expunction of human trafficking victim criminal history records; requiring a court to impose specified conditions on probationers or community controllees who are placed under supervision for committing a specified human trafficking offense on or after a certain date, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 1884 Preemption of Firearms and Ammunition Regulation by Rodrigues (R)

Preemption of Firearms and Ammunition Regulation; Providing that written or unwritten policies are subject to provisions allowing for recovery of damages if such policies violate specified provisions; providing that a plaintiff challenging a local government regulation concerning firearms is considered a prevailing plaintiff for certain purposes in specified circumstances, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 1890 Campaign Financing by Rodrigues (R)

Campaign Financing; Providing a limitation on contributions made to political committees sponsoring or opposing a constitutional amendment proposed by initiative; preempting counties, municipalities, and other local governmental entities from enacting or adopting any limitation or restriction involving certain contributions and expenditures, or establishing contribution limits different than those established in the Florida Election Code; prohibiting a candidate from donating surplus funds to a charitable organization

that employs the candidate; providing that any candidate required to dispose surplus funds may give certain surplus funds to the state or a political subdivision, to be disbursed in a specified manner, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 1934 Health Care Practitioner Discipline by Book

Health Care Practitioner Discipline; Subjecting health care practitioners to disciplinary action for specified offenses; revising provisions relating to immediate suspension of licensure to apply to all health care practitioners; requiring the Department of Health to issue emergency orders to suspend health care practitioners' licenses if they enter a criminal plea to, or are convicted or found guilty of, a felony relating to homicide or are arrested for committing or attempting, soliciting, or conspiring to commit acts that would constitute violations of specified criminal offenses, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 1966 Department of Business and Professional Regulation by Diaz

Department of Business and Professional Regulation; Requiring that certain reports relating to the transportation or possession of cigarettes be filed with the Division of Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco through the division's electronic data submission system; requiring that certain entities file reports, rather than returns, relating to tobacco products with the division; exempting certain persons from specified permit requirements under certain circumstances; authorizing specified establishments to submit a request for a temporary permit, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 2006 Emergency Management by Burgess

Emergency Management; Authorizing the Legislative Budget Commission to convene to transfer certain funds to the Emergency Preparedness and Response Fund; requiring that the state comprehensive emergency management plan provide for certain public health emergency communications and include the Department of Health's public health emergency plan; redefining the term "essentials" to include personal protective equipment used during public health emergencies; specifying requirements for the purpose and scope of emergency orders; authorizing the Governor to invalidate certain emergency orders; revising the duties of the State Health Officer during a declared public health emergency, etc. Effective Date: Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act, this act shall take effect July 1, 2021

SB 2500 Appropriations by Appropriations

Appropriations; Providing moneys for the annual period beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2022, and supplemental appropriations for the period ending June 30, 2021, to pay salaries, and other expenses, capital outlay - buildings, and other improvements, and for other specified purposes of the various agencies of state government, etc APPROPRIATION \$101,543,642,583. Effective Date: Except as otherwise provided herein, this act shall take effect July 1, 2021, or upon becoming law, whichever occurs later; however, if this act becomes law after July 1, 2021, then it shall operate retroactively to July 1, 2021

SB 2502 Implementing the 2021-2022 General Appropriations Act by Appropriations

Implementing the 2021-2022 General Appropriations Act; Incorporating by reference certain calculations of the Florida Education Finance Program; extending for 1 fiscal year authorization for the Department of Education to provide certain appropriated funds to certain education television stations and public colleges and universities for public broadcasting; authorizing the Agency for Health Care Administration, in consultation with the Department of Health, to submit a budget amendment to realign funding for a component of the Children's Medical Services program to reflect actual enrollment changes; extending for 1 year the exemption of certain rules pertaining to the medical use of marijuana from certain rulemaking requirements, etc. Effective Date: Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act and except for this section, which shall take effect upon this act becoming a law, this act shall take effect July 1, 2021, or, if this act fails to become a law until after that date, it shall take effect upon becoming a law and shall operate retroactively to July 1, 2021

SB 2504 Collective Bargaining by Appropriations

Collective Bargaining; Providing for the resolution of certain collective bargaining issues at impasse between the State of Florida and certified bargaining units of state employees; providing for all other collective bargaining issues at impasse which are not addressed by the act or the General Appropriations Act to be resolved consistent with personnel rules and by otherwise maintaining the status quo, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 2510 State Agency Law Enforcement Radio System by Appropriations

State Agency Law Enforcement Radio System; Revising expiration dates of provisions relating to the remission of surcharges for specified criminal offenses and noncriminal moving traffic violations to the Department of Revenue to fund the state agency law enforcement radio system and to provide technical assistance with respect to statewide systems of regional law enforcement communications, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 2512 Documentary Stamp Tax Distributions by Appropriations

Documentary Stamp Tax Distributions; Revising and deleting distributions of the documentary stamp tax; providing that specified distributions may not be transferred to the General Revenue Fund; revising the purposes for which distributions may be made from the Water Protection and Sustainability Program Trust Fund, etc. Effective Date: July 1, 2021, only if SB 1954 or similar legislation and SB 2514 or similar legislation are adopted in the same legislative session or an extension thereof and become law

SB 2518 Health Care by Appropriations

Health Care; Revising the amount of money residents of a veterans' nursing home must receive monthly before being required to contribute to their maintenance and support; revising the postpartum Medicaid eligibility period for pregnant women; revising the years of audited disproportionate share data the agency must use for calculating an average for purposes of calculating disproportionate share payments; revising the requirement that the agency make disproportionate share payments to certain specialty hospitals for children to apply to each fiscal year, rather than a specified fiscal year, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

HB 5011 Termination of the Lawton Chiles Endowment Fund by Appropriations Committee

Termination of the Lawton Chiles Endowment Fund: Directs SBA to liquidate assets in Lawton Chiles Endowment Fund by specified date; provides for transfer of balances in fund; provisions relating to creation & administration of Lawton Chiles Endowment Fund. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 5101 Education Funding by PreK-12 Appropriations Subcommittee

Education Funding: Revises calculation for determining amount of state funds received by Florida Virtual School for operating purposes; repeals provisions relating to reading scholarship accounts; revises certain requirements for school districts providing virtual instruction programs; removes provisions relating to specified funding allocations; revises provisions relating to adjustments to minimum base salary of certain employees; requires school districts to use specified federal funding allocations for specified purposes; provides requirements relating to continued participation in reading scholarship accounts program. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 5301 Judges by Justice Appropriations Subcommittee

Judges: Revises number of circuit court judges in certain circuits; revises number of county court judges in certain counties. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 5601 Higher Education by Higher Education Appropriations Subcommittee

Higher Education: Removing a provision relating to the maximum annual start-up and enhancement grant awarded per institution; revising eligibility criteria for the William L. Boyd, IV, Effective Access to Student Education grant program; requiring recipient institutions to submit a specified report to the Department of Education; expanding state university compensation limits to all state university employees, rather than only state university administrative employees, etc. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 6077 Assets of an Estate in Administration by Robinson (W)

Assets of an Estate in Administration: Removes requirement that assets of an estate in administration may only be placed in savings & loan association if it meets specified requirements. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 7011 Student Literacy by Early Learning & Elementary Education Subcommittee

Student Literacy: Provides & revises requirements relating to improvement of student literacy skills; requires DOE, in consultation with Office of Early Learning, to implement coordinated screening &

progress monitoring system for VPK program through grade 8; establishes Reading Achievement Initiative for Scholastic Excellence Program within DOE; revises requirements relating to specified reading instruction allocation; revises requirements for certain instructional personnel & professional development program. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 7017 Foreign Influence by Public Integrity & Elections Committee

Foreign Influence: Requiring any state agency or political subdivision to disclose certain gifts or grants received from any foreign source to the Department of Financial Services within a specified timeframe; requiring any entity that applies for a certain grant or proposes a certain contract to disclose to a state agency or political subdivision any current or prior interest of, contract with, or grant or gift received from a foreign country of concern under certain circumstances; requiring institutions of higher education to semiannually report to certain entities regarding certain gifts they received directly or indirectly from a foreign source; authorizing a whistle-blower to report an undisclosed foreign gift to the Attorney General or the Chief Financial Officer; authorizing the Chief Financial Officer to incur expenditures to provide such reward from the penalty recovery; requiring certain state universities and other entities to screen certain foreign applicants seeking employment in specified research positions; requiring certain state universities and other entities to establish an international travel approval and monitoring program, etc. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 7018 State-administered Retirement Systems by Governmental Oversight and Accountability

State-administered Retirement Systems; Revising required employer retirement contribution rates for each membership class and subclass of the Florida Retirement System; providing a declaration of important state interest, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 7022 OGSR/Proprietary Confidential Business Information by Regulated Industries

OGSR/Proprietary Confidential Business Information; Amending a provision which provides an exemption from public records requirements for proprietary confidential business information submitted by a voice communications services provider to the E911 Board, the Division of Telecommunications within the Department of Management Services, or the Department of Revenue; removing the scheduled repeal of the exemption, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

HB 7023 Veterans Treatment Court Programs by Criminal Justice & Public Safety Subcommittee

Veterans Treatment Court Programs: Authorizes courts to create & administer veterans treatment court programs; requires such programs to adopt certain policies & procedures; provides eligibility criteria for participation in program; authorizes court to impose condition requiring certain probationers or community controllees to participate in treatment programs. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 7045 School Choice by Education & Employment Committee

School Choice: Revises student eligibility requirements under Family Empowerment Scholarship program to include students with disabilities; revises provisions related to calculation of maximum amount of scholarship funds granted to a student with disabilities; revises provisions related to funding and payment of scholarships awarded under program; providing requirements for use of funds under program; revising program administration obligations; repeals Gardiner Scholarship Program; provides for future repeal of John M. McKay Scholarships for Students with Disabilities Program; providing certain students with disabilities are eligible for enrollment in transition-to-work programs; revising amount of eligible contributions used for administrative expenses by an eligible nonprofit scholarship-funding organization under Florida Tax Credit Scholarship Program. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

HB 7051 Law Enforcement and Correctional Officer Practices by Judiciary Committee

Law Enforcement and Correctional Officer Practices: Requires application for employment or appointment as law enforcement or correctional officer to contain specified disclosures; requires background investigation of applicant to include specified information; requires employing agencies to maintain employment information for minimum period; requires establishment of standards for officer training & policies concerning use of force; requires law enforcement agencies to establish policies for specified use of force investigations; requires investigation to include an independent report; requires report to be submitted to state attorney; requires law enforcement agencies to submit specified data to FDLE; prohibits child younger than certain age from being arrested, charged, or adjudicated delinquent for delinquent act or violation of law. Effective Date: July 1, 2021

SB 7056 **Trust Funds** by Appropriations

Trust Funds; Terminating the Public Defenders Revenue Trust Fund within the Justice Administrative Commission; repealing provisions relating to the Public Defenders Revenue Trust Fund; terminating the Welfare Transition Trust Fund within the Department of Military Affairs; terminating the Welfare Transition Trust Fund within the Department of Health, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

HB 7061 **Taxation** by Ways & Means Committee

Taxation: Specifying that portions of property not used for certain purposes are not exempt from ad valorem taxation; specifying that exemptions for certain portions of property from ad valorem taxation are not affected so long as such portions of property are used for specified purposes; exempting certain multifamily projects from ad valorem taxation; requiring, rather than authorizing, tax collectors to accept late payments of prepaid property taxes within a certain timeframe; extending the expiration date of the sales tax exemption for data center property; exempting specified items that assist in independent living from the sales tax, etc. Effective Date: Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act this act shall take effect July 1, 2021

SB 7072 **Social Media Platforms** by Governmental Oversight and Accountability

Social Media Platforms; Prohibiting a social media platform from willfully deplatforming a candidate; providing requirements for public contracts and economic incentives related to entities that have been convicted or held civilly liable for antitrust violations; providing that social media platforms that fail to comply with specified requirements and prohibitions commit an unfair or deceptive act or practice; authorizing the Department of Legal Affairs to investigate suspected violations under the Deceptive and Unfair Trade Practices Act and bring specified actions for such violations, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021

SB 7074 **Public Records/Social Media Platform Activities** by Governmental Oversight and Accountability

Public Records/Social Media Platform Activities; Providing a public records exemption for information received by the Attorney General pursuant to an investigation by the Attorney General or a law enforcement agency into certain social media platform activities; providing a public records exemption for information received by the Department of Legal Affairs pursuant to an investigation by the department or a law enforcement agency into violations by certain social media platforms; providing for future legislative review and repeal of the exemption; providing a statement of public necessity, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2021
