Subject: Nominate Yourself or Recommend a Leader for FSBA Executive Officer Position

Dear School Board members,

We are currently seeking nominations for executive officer positions in FSBA, and I encourage you to consider taking a leadership role or recommending a qualified colleague. Nominations are open today through **March 13, 2026**.

Here's a simplified overview of the executive officer election process.

- Per FSBA Bylaws, the following positions will be up for election annually:
 - President-elect
 - Vice president
 - Treasurer
- Dr. Allison Campbell (Marion), current President-Elect, will become President as per FSBA Bylaws.
- I, as Immediate Past President, will chair the Nominating Committee.
- The Nominating Committee will meet (electronically) on **Monday, March 30, 2026**, for an organizational meeting, and again on **April 13, 2026**, to interview all applicants. *Please hold April 13th open for your interview which will be scheduled after all applications are received.*
- The Nominating Committee will recommend a slate of officers to the General Membership to be presented for a vote at the General Membership Meeting in **June 2026**.

Application process:

- All materials in the application must be received by 5:00 p.m. EST on **Friday, March 13, 2026**.
- Things to consider if you are nominating someone or yourself:
 - time commitment and travel requirements for those serving (*view link above*)
 - home school board knowledge and support of personal desire to serve (or that of your nominee)
 - ability to positively benefit the Association
- FSBA staff will contact you the week of **March 23, 2026** to schedule your virtual interview with the Nominating Committee on **April 13, 2026**.
